Dr. Naresh Kumar Baghmar (b. 15-08-1956), Professor in Geography; obtained M.A. (Merit 5th position) and M.Phil. (With merit) degree in Geography from Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur (C.G.) in 1979 and 1980 respectively and joined the post of lecturer in Durga Mahavidyalaya in 1981 and as a Cartographer (1985) in Geography Department Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur and as a lecturer (1993) as a Senior lecturer(1998) and a Reader in 2003 and Professor in 2012. The title of his Ph.D. thesis is “Water Resource Potential use and Development in Raipur District: A Geographical Analysis”. He was awarded Ph. D. degree in 1988. His field of specialization and area of interest are Resource studies, Remote Sensing and Geographical Information System.

For the improvement of academic excellence Dr. Baghmar completed the technical courses on Remote Sensing and GIS at Indian Institute of Remote Sensing at Deharadun (1993) and National Remote Sensing Agency at Hyderabad (1997). About 18 research papers are published in various journals of Geography. He attended 31 National and International Conferences. Seven Research Scholar are awarded Ph.D degree under the guidance of Dr. Baghmar and 6 are working for Ph. D. He has performed the duties as a Coordinator (C.V.) and Superintendent of University Exams. Superintendent in U.P.S.C. exam. and exam by Vyasvic Pariksha Mandal many times. He has organized workshops on Remote Sensing and GIS (2005, 2006, and 2007) for improvement of knowledge for college Geography Teachers. Dr. Baghmar is the Only Geography teacher in Chhattisgarh to teach to the Remote Sensing and GIS paper. He has attended 08 International and 52 National Conferences.
