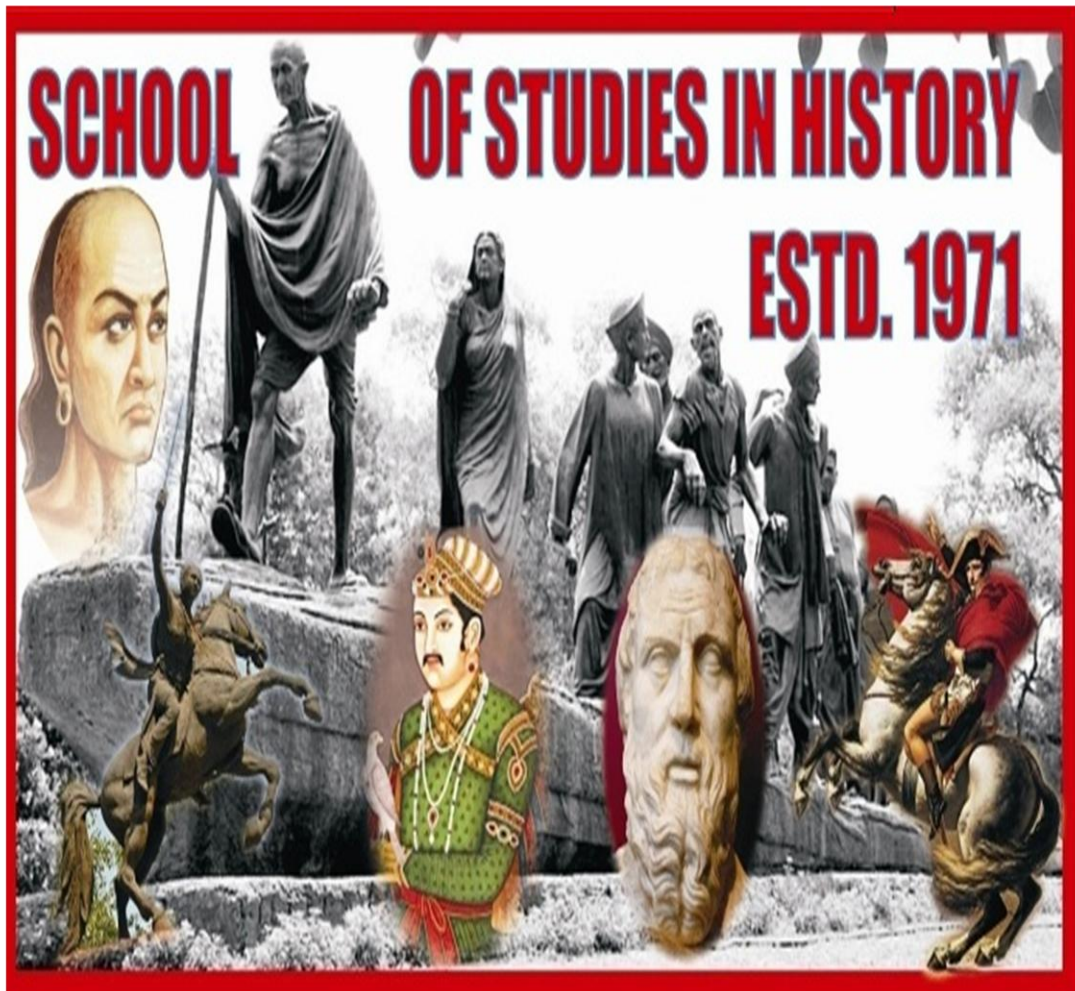

About the University

Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University is Chhattisgarh's largest and oldest institution of higher education, founded in 1964, and named after the first chief minister of erstwhile Madhya Pradesh. The University has a sprawling campus in the western part of Raipur. The campus of University is spread over 207 acres of land. There are Twenty-Nine teaching departments in the University. Attracted by the opportunity to study and conduct advanced research with renowned professors and fellow scholars in one of the Chhattisgarh's most dynamic cities, students come from the neighboring States too. There are 5000 students enrolled for variety of courses offered by different departments who are steered under the guidance of more than 100 faculty members.

School of Studies in History

The school of Studies in History as a University Teaching Department of Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University was established in August 1971 with the purpose to provide teaching and research facilities to students and scholars in History of Modern India and Regional History. The P.G. program was initiated since its inception, Ph.D. was started in 1974 and M. Phil in 1985-86. The CBCS (Choice Based Credit System) has been introduced in the Department since 2015-16. History proved to be a popular subject among the student of different subjects and faculties. The strength of the CBCS was over 90 students in the previous batch i.e. in the academy session of 2015-16. Admission to all courses are given on the basis of academic career of the candidates and marks secured in an Entrance Test. A number of Seminars and Workshops have been organized to keep the students, scholars and the faculty updated.

Admission to M.A., M.Phil and Ph.D. courses are made on the basis of the marks obtained in the Entrance Test including weightage of sports achievements, NCC/NSS marks as per the policy of the University/UGC/State Government.

M.A. (Master of Arts)

Eligibility:- Graduation with score of at least 50% marks

M.Phil. (Master of Philosophy) / Ph.D. (Doctor of Philosophy)

Eligibility:-Master of Arts in History with score of at least 55% Marks

Note:- The reservation in seats and relaxation in the qualifying marks for SC/ST/OBC/PWD and other Categories shall be as per the rules of the Central/State Government policy whichever is applicable.
