
Day 1 09.01.2023

Increasing emphasis on interdisciplinary / collaborated research, technology-aided empirical research, relatively shorter duration of research in a 'big data' era, as well as quality and integrity of research reports, among others, have attracted increased attention in contemporary social science research.

Title: Social Challenges and role of social scientist in India

He mentioned Social scientists study all aspects of society—from past events and achievements to human behaviour and relationships among groups. Their research provides insights into the different ways individuals, groups, and institutions make decisions, exercise power, and respond to change. He also discussed there are several difficulties in applying social science successfully to the solution of social problems. Limitations such as "Hawthorne effects" or changes in behaviour which result from the fact that individuals are subjects in an experimental study can be one main problem of social researches Social science is a key



The introduction of categorical variables (Nominal and Ordinal) and continuous variables (Interval and Ratio) was done with insights of the distinguishing between these variables.

Title: "Instrumentalisation of social science in India with particular reference to Anthropology and Sociology".



In his lecture, he discussed in detail about the importance and issues of inter disciplinary research in social science.


He emphasized that research studies based on one subject cannot prove to be meaningful in solving any social problem today. For this we have to adopt an inter-disciplinary approach.


