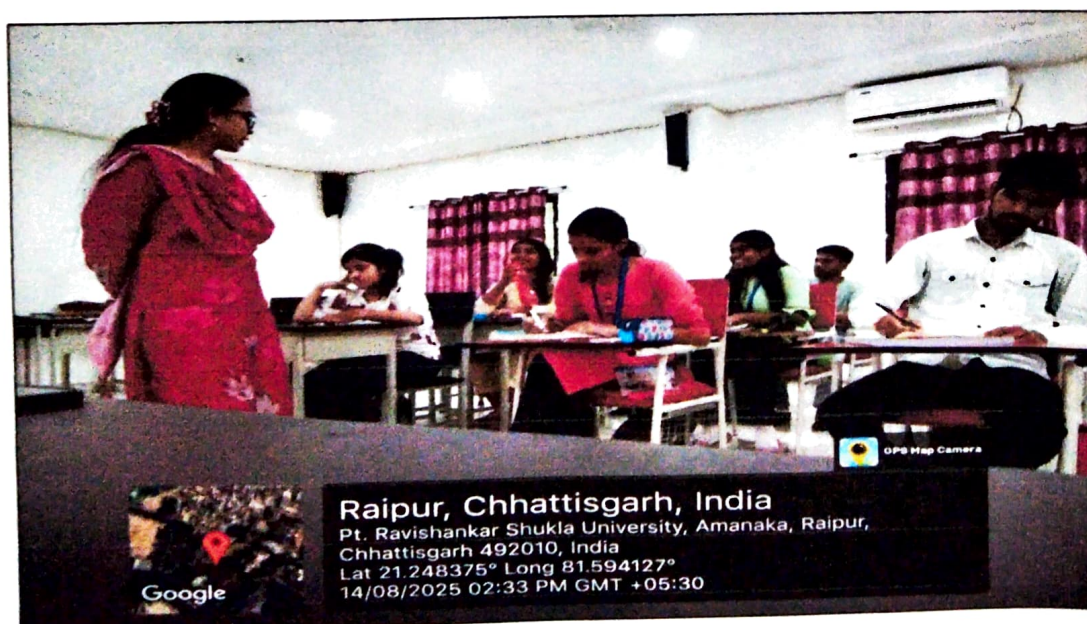

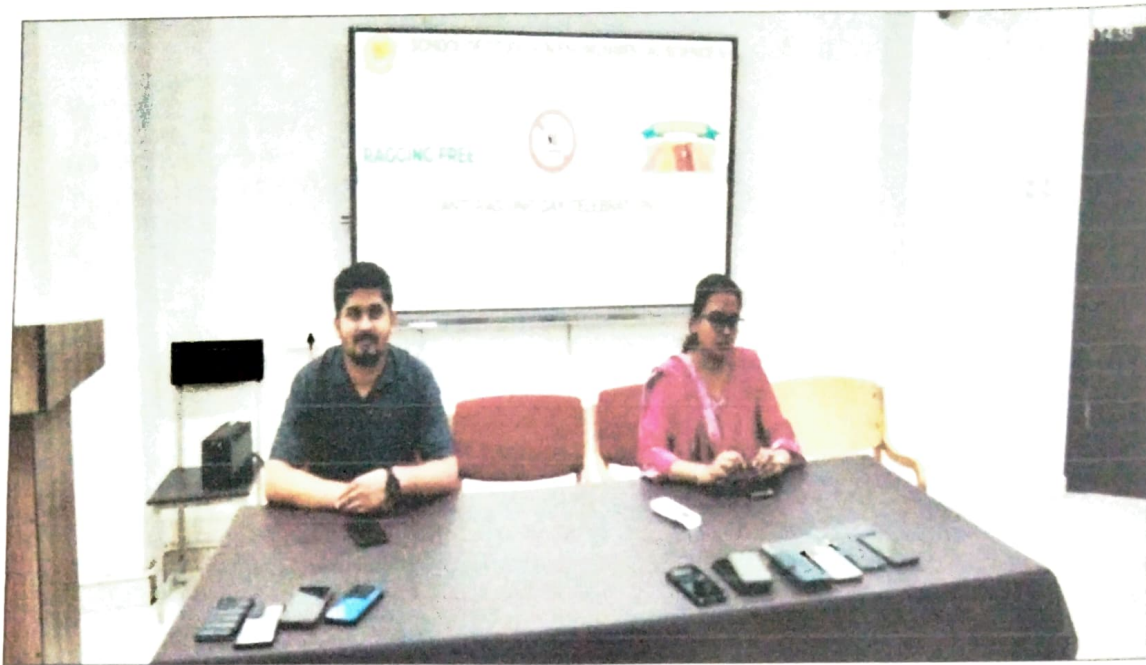
The events organized are as follows:

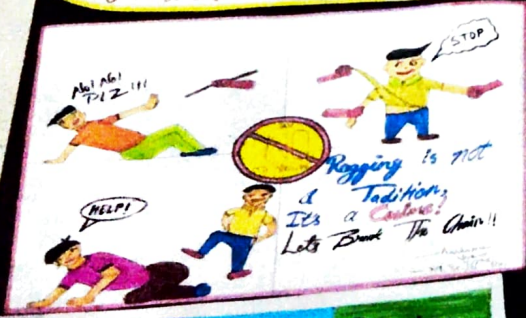
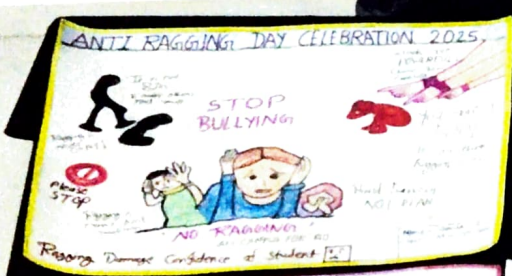
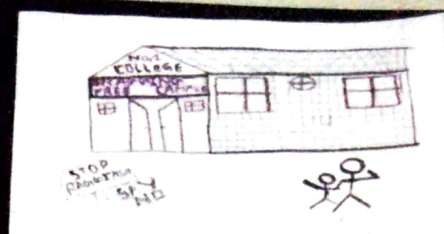


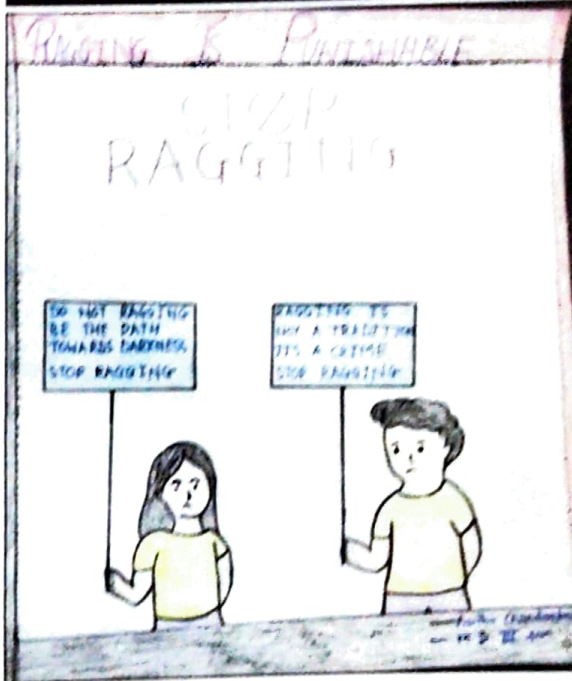
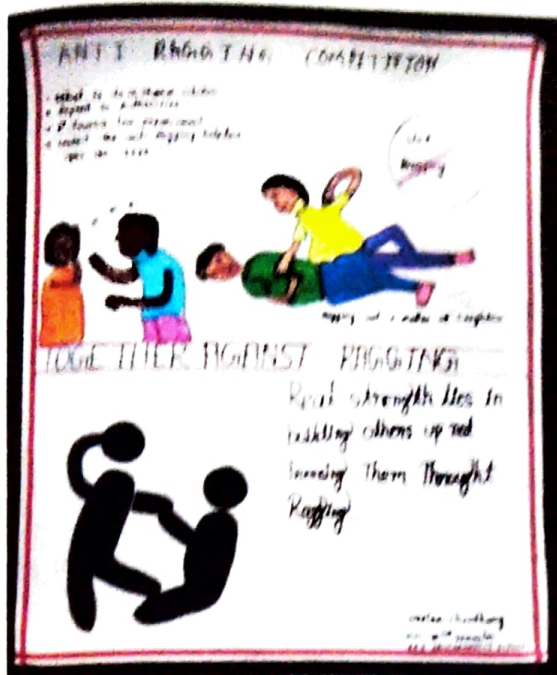
Poster Making Competitions:

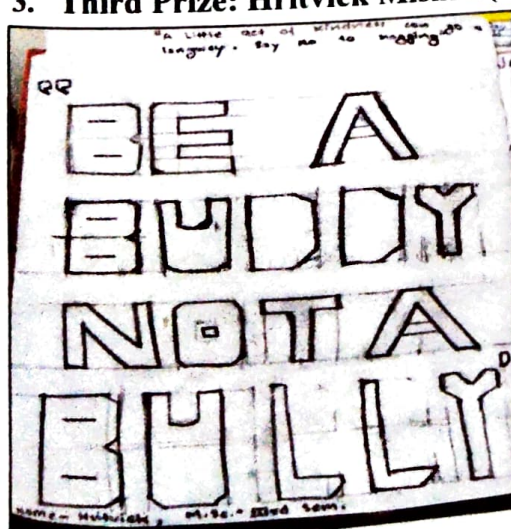





The poster making competition was a vibrant and impactful event that effectively communicated the importance of standing against ragging. Through the power of visuals,


