About the National Seminar

Tribal populations have remained 'unsung heroes' of our nation and it is attempted to bring their knowledge and indigenous systems into light. This rich knowledge can then be further utilised for planning and sustainable development of the nation. The seminars intends to include specialists and researchers from diverse disciplines as well as tribal traditional healers, chiefs etc in order to gain in-depth understanding of various issues of traditional knowledge, development and sustainable development, tribal situation in the traditional knowledge and knowledge sharing, Intellectual Property Rights (IPR), health, ecology, science and technology etc. The seminar aspires for joint knowledge sharing and problem-solving through the involvement of members of tribal community, tribal experts, and varied subject specialists. It shall cover various sub-themes for discussion like Traditional medical knowledge, systems, and health, Natural resources, Environment, and eco-system management, Disaster management, Communities and rights over traditional knowledge, Development programmes and knowledge sharing, Reproductive and Child health etc. The seminar is proposed to spread over four-days with key-note speakers, paper and poster presentations, and a one-day field visit to nearby tribal area.
