Course work with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and successfully completing the M.Phil. Degree shall be eligible to proceed to do research work leading to the Ph. D. Degree in the same Institution. A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/differently-abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

A person, whose M.Phil. dissertation has been evaluated and the viva voce is pending may be admitted to the Ph.D. program of the same Institution.

However, in order encourage research interest among teachers of this category, exemption from five years P.G. teaching or 10 years U.G. teaching shall be granted to those who have been awarded with research projects from the State (for example, CCOST)/ National (for example, DST, CSIR, UGC etc.)/ International (for example, WHO, Ford Foundation etc.) Sponsoring Agencies or those who have already published at least five papers in SCI/ SSCI/ A&HCI journals (as listed and revised by Thomson Reuters from time to time). A Scientist/ Director/ Scholar, not below the rank of a University lecturer/ Assistant Professor. working in a research Institute/ Organization/ Establishment/ Laboratory/ Library & Physical Education Professionals Library/ working in Physical Education Department, recognized by the University as a research Centre, who has obtained a Doctorate Degree in the subject/ appointed as a scientist/ teacher in the

approval of the RDC.

The allocation of Research Supervisor for

a selected research scholar shall be decided by the DRC concerned depending on the number of scholars per Research Supervisor, the available specialization among the Supervisors and research interests of the scholars as indicated by them at the time of interview/viva voce. In case of topics which are of interdisciplinary nature where the Department concerned feels that the expertise in the Department has to be supplemented from outside, the Department may appoint a Research Supervisor from the Department itself, who shall be known as the Research Supervisor, and a Co-Supervisor from outside the Department/ Faculty/College/Institution on such terms and conditions as may be specified and agreed upon by the consenting Institutions/Colleges.

A Research Supervisor/Co-supervisor who is a Professor, at any given point of time, cannot guide more than three (3) M.Phil. and Eight (8) Ph.D. scholars. An Associate Professor as Research Supervisor can guide up to a maximum of two (2) M.Phil. and six (6) Ph.D. scholars and an Assistant Professor as Research Supervisor can guide up to a maximum of one (1) M.Phil. and four (4) Ph.D. scholars.

In case of relocation of an M.Phil/Ph.D. woman scholar due to marriage or otherwise, the research data shall be allowed to be transferred to the University to which the scholar intends to relocate provided all the other conditions in these regulations are followed in letter and spirit and the research work does not pertain to the project secured by the parent institution/ supervisor from any funding agency. The scholar will however give due credit to the parent guide and the institution for the part of research already done.
