	<b>A</b> A candidate for the degree of Doctor of Philosophy must, at the time of application, holds Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (50 % marks for SC/ST/DIFFERENTLY ABLED CANDIDATE)/ B in the seven point scale/ an equivalent grade point average of a University, a deemed University or any other University incorporated by any law for the time being in force and recognized by the University OR Holds M.Phil. degree of a University, a deemed University or any other University incorporated by any law for the time being in force and recognized by the University OR A candidate who has at least 7 years experience of research/ teaching with at least 5 papers published in standard research journal, even if he/she does not possess 55% marks at Master's degree.	<b>A</b> Candidates for admission to the PhD program shall have a Master's degree or a professional degree declared equivalent to the Master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions. 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


