ORDINANCE No. 158

M.Sc. (Medical Biotechnology)

- 1. The degree of Master of Science in Medical Biotechnology shall be of two academic years.
- 2. The course shall be run by the S.O.S. in Biotechnology of the University or by Pt. J.N.M. Medical College, Raipur.
- 3. The eligibility for admission shall for a candidate who has passed B.Sc. examination with two of the subjects from among; Botany, Zoology, Microbiology, Industrial Microbiology, Biotechnology or any relevant discipline of Biological Sciences and Chemistry as one of the subject or M.B.B.S. of this University or an examination of any statutory University which has been recognized by the University as equivalent to.
- 4. The structure of the course along with the scheme of the examination shall be prescribed by the Board of Studies in Biotechnology under the Faculty of Life Sciences. The Board of Studies will consider the syllabus for this course as proposed by DBT (Department of Biotechnology) under the Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India or U.G.C. or any statutory body.
- 5. The examination for the degree of Master of Science in Medical Biotechnology shall comprise of two parts:
 - a. The Previous Examination and
 - b. The Final Examination.
- 6. For both the previous and final examinations, a candidate shall be declared successful if he/ she obtains at least 40% marks in theory, practical, internal assessments, project report separately.
- 7. A candidate shall be declared pass only if he/ she secures 50% marks in aggregate.
- 8. No division shall be awarded on the result M.Sc. Medical Biotechnology previous examination.

- 9. Successful candidates who obtains 60% or more marks shall be placed in First Division and those obtaining below 60% marks shall be declared pass with second division.
- 10. Other provisions regarding admission, attendance examination etc. shall be as per the relevant ordinances of the University.
