Dear Sir/Madam,

The University Grants Commission introduced the scheme of Centres with Potential for Excellence in Particular Areas (CPEPA) during IX plan period in order to promote quality and excellence and inter-disciplinary approach in teaching and research activities. Since then, this initiative has been continuing and now it has become part of the XII Plan schemes. Presently, UGC is supporting 21 Centres under the scheme and UGC intends to increase the number of Centres upto 50, including the existing ones, during the XII Plan period. The broad objective of the Scheme is to encourage and facilitate the chosen departments at the selected universities to work together by associating their faculty members to cooperate and collaborate in their programmes and activities on a regular basis, by cutting across departmental and/or discipline barriers in the emerging, frontier or cutting edge subject areas of regional, national and/or international importance. One of the objectives of the Scheme is to gradually prepare the universities for UPE status. The guidelines of the scheme have been posted on UGC website www.ugc.ac.in. All universities including State private universities and self-financed deemed to be universities are eligible for consideration under the Scheme subject to the fulfillment of the criteria as laid down in the guidelines. However, financial assistance will be provided only to such universities which are receiving General Development Assistance from UGC. If interested, you may send the proposal of your university as per the prescribed proforma i.e. Annexure-I of the guidelines of the scheme to the Under Secretary (PE), Room No. 205, University Grants Commission, Bahadurshah Zafar Marg, New Delhi – 110 002 latest by 30th September, 2014. Proposals received after due date will not be considered.

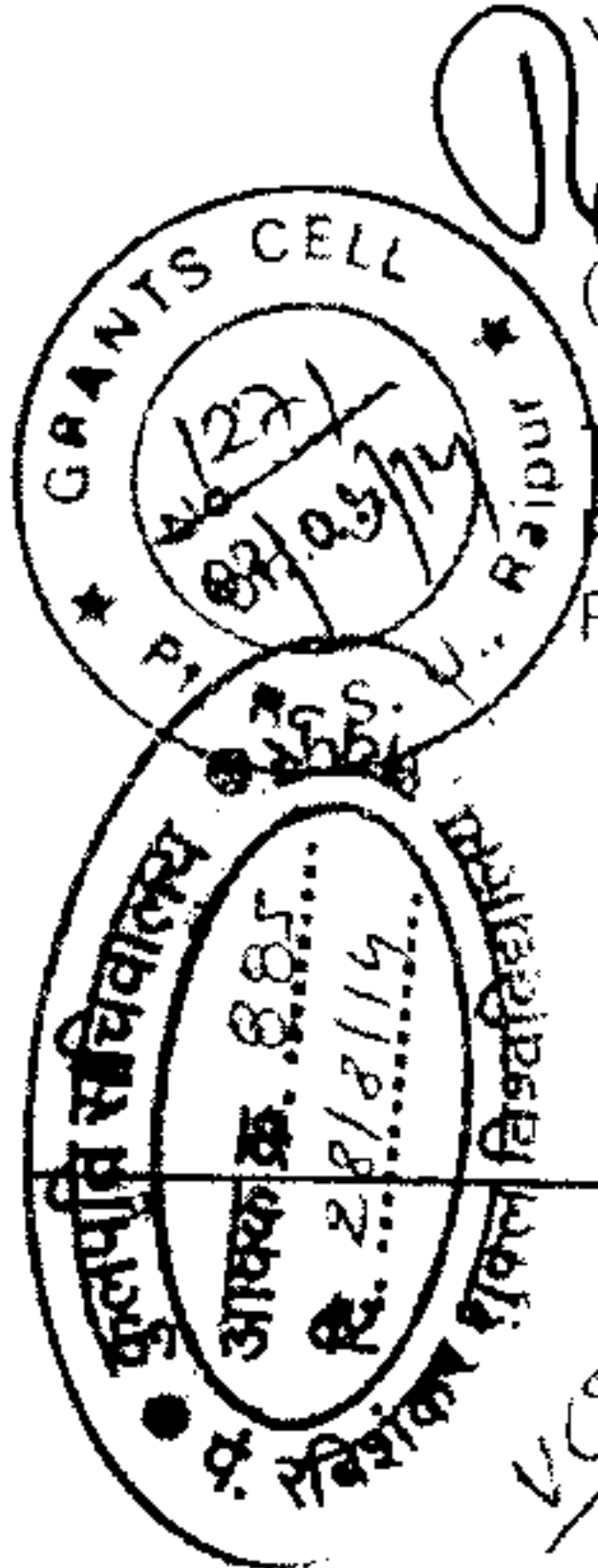
