## ORDINANCE No. 55

### MASTER OF SCIENCE (HOME SCIENCE) EXAMINATION

The examination for the degree of Master of Science (Home Science) consist of two parts :

- (a) The Previous Examination and
  - (b) The Final Examination.
2. "A candidate who after obtaining the Degree of Bachelor of SCIENCE (HOME SCIENCE) and Bachelor of SCIENCE with one year Diploma Course in the following -
1. Diploma in Dietetics (M.Sc.in F.N.)
  2. Diploma in Food Science and Nutrition (M.Sc.in F.N.)
  3. Diploma in Sports Science & Nutrition (M.Sc.in F.N.)
  4. Diploma in Textile Designing & Technology (M.Sc.in Tex.)
  5. Diploma in Fashio/Costume Designing (M.Sc.in Textile)
  6. Diploma in Interior Decoration (M.Sc.in H.M.)
  7. Diploma in Housing Construction (M.Sc.in H.M.)
  8. Diploma in Early Childhood Education/Nursery School Education (M.Sc.in C.D.)
  9. Diploma in Child Development (M.Sc.in C.D.)
  10. Diploma in Guidance & Counselling (M.Sc.in C.D.)
  11. Diploma in Social Welfare (M.Sc.in Extension)
  12. Diploma in Extension Education (M.Sc.in Extension)
- of the University or an Examination of any Statutory University in India which has been recognised by the University as equivalent to the B.Sc.(Home Science) Degree of the University, shall be admitted to the previous Examination for the Degree of Master of Home Science."
3. A candidate who, after passing the M.H.Sc. Previous Examination of the University, has completed a regular course of study for one academic year in a teaching department of the University or in a college affiliated to the University, shall be admitted to the Final Examination for the degree of Master of Science (Home Science) in the subject in which he/she has passed the Previous Examination.
- A candidate, who has passed the Previous Examination for the degree of Master of Science (Home Science) of another University, may also be admitted to the Final Examination for the degree of Master of Science (Home Science), after obtaining previous permission of the Kulpati provided that he/she offered for his/her Previous Examination a course of study of a equivalent standard with almost identical syllabus as is required for the Previous Examination of this University, and has attended a regular course of study for one academic year in a teaching department of the University or in a college affiliated to the university.
4. The Examination shall be partly be means of papers and partly practical including sessionals.
5. The subject of examination shall be one of the following :
- (i) Food & Nutrition.
  - (ii) Resource Management
  - (iii) Human Development
  - (iv) Textile & Clothing.
  - (v) Education Extension.
6. In order to pass at any of the Previous or Final Examination, an examinee must obtain not less than : -
- (i) 33% in each theory paper and aggregate of 40% in total theory papers.
  - (ii) 40% in each practical.
  - (iii) 40% for sessionals.
7. The division in which a candidate is placed shall be determined on the basis of aggregate marks obtained in total, the M.Sc.(Home Science) Previous and the M.Sc.(Home Science) Final Examination. No division will be assigned on the result of the Previous Examination.
8. Successful candidates who obtain 60 percent or more of the aggregate marks shall be placed in the first division

those obtaining less than 60 percent but not less than 48 percent in the second division and all other successful candidates obtaining less than 48 percent in the third division.

9. Candidates who have passed the M.Sc. (Home Science) examination of the University in any subject in third or second division and desire to appear at the M.Sc. (Home Science) Examination in the same subject for improving division may, without attending a regular course of study in a college affiliated to the University or in a teaching department of the University be allowed to appear at the aforesaid examination as non-collegiate students on the following conditions : -

- (i) There shall be only two divisions for such candidates i.e. First Division and Second Division. The marks required for obtaining these divisions shall be the same as prescribed in this Ordinance i.e. examinees who are successful in final of the examination and have obtained 60% or more of the aggregate marks in previous and final of the examinations taken together shall be placed in the First Division and examinees who are successful in final of the examination and have obtained less than 60 percent but not less than 48 percent of the aggregate marks in previous and final of the examinations taken together shall be placed in the Second Division.
- (ii) The results of the candidates obtaining less than 48 percent of the aggregate marks in Previous and Final of the Examinations taken together shall not be declared.
- (iii) Candidates shall have the option to appear at both the Previous and the Final Examinations in one and the same year and for being successful at the Examination, the candidates shall obtain 48 percent of the aggregate marks.
- (iv) The syllabus for the examination shall be the same as prescribed for the year in which the examination is held.
- (v) Not more than two attempts shall be allowed to such candidates. Failure or non-appearance at the examination after permission has been accorded by the University, shall be counted as an attempt.  
Provided, however, such candidates who opt to appear at the Previous and Final examinations separately will be allowed only one attempt at the previous examination and two attempts at the final examination.
- (vi) Candidates who wish to avail the opportunity given in foregoing paras, will have to apply for permission as required in the Ordinance relating to admission of non-collegiate students to the University examination along-with requisite Registration fee.
- (vii) In case, student improves his division under provision of this para, the fresh degree will be issued after cancelling his first degree.

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
