विश्वविद्यालय कार्यपरिषद् की बैठक दिनांक 23.10.2024 के अध्यक्ष के अनुमति से निर्णय क्रमांक 1 एवं छत्तीसगढ़ शासन, उच्च शिक्षा विभाग, मंत्रालय, महानदी भवन, नवा रायपुर अटल नगर, रायपुर से प्राप्त पत्र क्रमांक एफ 3-45/2024/38-2 दिनांक 25.02.2025 के अनुक्रम में अध्यादेश क्रमांक 180 "LLB. THREE YEARS LAW DEGREE COURSE" में संशोधन, माननीय कुलाधिपति महोदय द्वारा अनुमोदित को अंगीकृत किए जाने का निर्णय लिया गया, जो निम्नांकित है -

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ORDINANCE No. 180 LL.B. THREE YEARS LAW DEGREE COURSE	01 The course for the Degree of the Bachelor of Laws (Semester System) under this ordinance shall extend over a period of three academic years comprising of six semesters in all, for each semester there shall be held an Examination in the paper prescribed for the said semester concerned. LL.B. Part I – First Semester LL.B. Part I – Second Semester LL.B. Part II – First Semester LL.B. Part II – Second Semester LL.B. Part III – First Semester LL.B. Part III – Second Semester These semester examinations shall be held at Raipur and such other place as the Academic Council or the Executive Council may determine from time to time.	<i>“Bachelor degree in law” means and includes a degree in law conferred by the University recognized by the Bar Council of India for the purpose of the Act and includes a bachelor degree in law after any bachelor degree in science, arts, commerce, engineering, medicine, or any other discipline of a University for a period of study not less than three years. And compression for not less than a period of Three years (6 Semester) after graduation herewith after shall be designated in short LLB.</i>
	02 LL.B. First Semester shall be commencing from the month of July every year and the Semester examination shall be held in the month of January of the following year. Examination for all the semester shall be held twice a year namely January/February and July/August.	<i>Duration of the program The program of study for LLB. shall extend over a period of six semesters (Three academic years). 05	<p>a) In order to declare successful at any of the LL.B. Semester Examination every Candidate will have to obtain at least 36% marks in individual papers and at least 48% marks in aggregate. Provided that for the purpose of declaration of the result of Candidate appearing LL.B. Part-III Second Semester Examination the marks obtained by them in the written examination as well as in practical/viva-voce shall be taken into account. A successful candidate shall be assigned division on the basis of the marks obtained by him/her in all the six semester examinations taken together. Those who secure 60% marks or more shall be placed in the FIRST DIVISION. Prohibition against lateral entry and exit</p> <p>There shall be no lateral entry on the plea of graduation in any subject or exit by way of awarding a degree.</p> <p>Admission Process for the Students from Universities other than Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur or Colleges- It is being proposed that if a student who after having passed LLB first semester and second semester from another university or College and wants to take admission in LLB third semester, similarly having passed LLB first to forth semester and wants to take admission in LLB fifth semester of Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University then that student will be eligible for</p>

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		admission only if the syllabus of each semesters of other university or College is same to same as of Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur.
13	No Provision in Present	13. Award of degree A successful candidate shall be awarded division on the basis of marks obtained by him/her in all six semester examination taken together. Those who secure 60% or more shall be in 1st division. All other successful candidates' having marks less than 60% shall be placed in 2nd division.
14	No Provision in Present	14. Duration for completion of the program of study <i>The duration for the completion of the program shall be fixed as double the actual duration minus one year (i.e. within 5 years from the date of admission) of the program and the students have to pass within the said period, otherwise their admission will stand cancelled.</i>
15	No Provision in Present	<i>15. Not Eligible for LLB three Years course- Mark sheets are not generated from the University for the Students who admitted in first semester but did not submitted the form or appeared in semester exams. Those students will not be eligible for readmission in LLB three Years Course and also not come into the category of Ex-Students.</i>
16	No Provision in Present	16. Revaluation / Retotaling of answer papers <i>There is no provision for revaluation of the answer papers in any examination.</i>

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		<i>However, the candidates can apply for retotaling by paying prescribed fee.</i>
17	No Provision in Present	17. The conditions / stipulations of above ordinance will be subject to rules and regulations made or modified by the Bar Council of India in respect of Rules of Legal Education as framed and amended from time to time.
18	No Provision in Present	18. <i>The provisions of Ordinances 5 and 6 shall be applicable only to the extent that they are not inconsistent with the provision of this Ordinance.</i>
