विश्वविद्यालय कार्यपरिषद् की बैठक दिनांक 23.10.2024 के अध्यक्ष के अनुमति से निर्णय क्रमांक 1 एवं छत्तीसगढ़ शासन, उच्च शिक्षा विभाग, मंत्रालय, महानदी भवन, नवा रायपुर अटल नगर, रायपुर से प्राप्त पत्र क्रमांक एफ 3-46/2024/38-2 दिनांक 25.02.2025 के अनुक्रम में अध्यादेश क्रमांक 179 "B.A.LL.B. (FIVE YEAR INTEGRATED DEGREE COURSE)" में संशोधन, माननीय कुलाधिपति महोदय द्वारा अनुमोदित को अंगीकृत किए जाने का निर्णय लिया गया, जो निम्नांकित है -

<b>ORDINANCE No. 179 B.A.LL.B. (FIVE YEAR INTEGRATED DEGREE COURSE)</b>	01 The whole period of this integrated B.A.LL.B course divided into five academic years/ classes known as B.A.LL.B Semester first, second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh, eighth, ninth and tenth semesters respectively. Every year /class is divided into Two Semesters WINTER and SUMMER Semesters. The examination of winter semester of all the classes will be called as WINTER TERM EXAMINATION and the other one would be known as SUMMER TERM EXAMINATION. In other words the course is extended into TEN SEMESTERS. The winter semesters are known as ODD semesters ( I, III, V, VII , IX ) while the summer semesters are known as EVEN semesters ( II, IV, VI, VIII , X ).	The "Bachelor degree in law" means and includes a degree in law conferred by the University recognized by the Bar Council of India for the purpose of the Act and includes an integrated bachelor degree combining the course of a first bachelor degree in Arts subject and also the law running together in concert and compression for not less than a period of five years after 10+2 or 11+1 courses as the case may be of 5 years (10 Semester) duration herewith after shall be designated in short BALLB.
	02 The details syllabus/ course of studies for each semester/ academic year and marking scheme for examination, etc. for this course shall be framed and approved by the Board of Studies and Law faculty duly constituted in accordance with the provision of the University Statute and Act. The syllabus forming bodies can amend/ modify the syllabus if needed in the light of BCI norms, time to time.	<i>Duration of the program</i> <b>The program of study for BALLB. shall extend over a period of ten semesters (Five academic years). The curricula and syllabi for the program shall be prescribed from time to time by University.</b>  <b>These Semesters shall be called as-</b> <b>BALLB- First Semester</b> <b>BALLB- Second Semester</b>

May 1- June 15	<p><b>Minimum qualification for admission</b></p> <p>The minimum qualification for admission to first semester of BALLB course will be who has successfully completed Senior Secondary School course ('+2') or equivalent (such as 11+1, 'A' level in Senior School Leaving certificate course) recognized by the university or passed Higher Secondary School Examination of Chhattisgarh Board of Higher Secondary Examination, Raipur has scored not less than 45 % of the maximum marks (40% for SC, ST reserved category) or a recognized Senior Secondary Board or equivalent, constituted or recognized by the Union or by a State Government or from any equivalent institution from a foreign country recognized by the government of that country for the purpose of issue of qualifying certificate on successful completion of the course, may apply for and be admitted into the program of the Centres of Legal Education to obtain the integrated degree in law with a degree in any other subject as the first degree from the University whose such a degree in law is recognized by the Bar Council of India for the purpose of enrolment.</p>
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			<p>Provided that applicants who have obtained + 2 Higher Secondary Pass Certificate or First Degree Certificate after prosecuting studies in distance or correspondence method shall also be considered as eligible for admission in the Integrated Five Years course LL.B. course, as the case may be.</p>




