

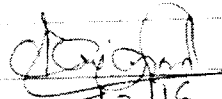

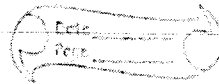

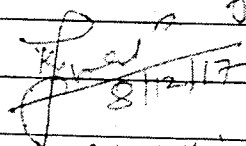

Proceedings:

• The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

• As per the discussion done with the external subject experts, the Board members prepared the structure of new syllabi for M.A. English Semesters I, II, III & IV.

• A new paper entitled Language Management and Communication Skills has been introduced in Semester I and II.

Justification: This paper has been included in order to provide a balance (of five papers in each semester) and to bring it at par with the syllabi of other standard universities of India. This would help the students who want to do higher studies in other universities.

Secondly, it has been found that the students of the state who seek admission to post graduation in English lack language skills, particularly writing skills. So a separate paper on language and communication skills would enhance

their the linguistic competence.

- The rest of the papers/courses - Poetry, Prose, Drama and Fiction would be same. However they have also been restructured to suit the present needs of the students.

- In Semester II and IV the Paper V A 'Romanticism' will be replaced by 'New Literatures in English' and Paper V B 'Modernist Literature' by Research Methodology and Computer Applications.

It is to be noted that in the previous meeting 'Literature of Protest' was suggested as Paper V A. But, then in further discussions done in the informal meetings held by the chairperson, it was decided that 'New Literatures in English' would be a better choice. The external experts Dr VC Sudhakar and Dr Abha Pandey were contacted and they gave their approval to the above change.

- After getting the experts' consent, the active members of the Board Dr Pratibha Sahasrabudhe and Dr Anita Jangra under the supervision of the Chairperson did lot of spare work for months together and structured the courses of 'Language Management and Communication Skills', 'New Literatures in English' and 'Research Methodology and Computer Applications'. After much deliberations the new courses have been given the final shape and it

The Board today gave approval to it.

- In addition to the syllabi furnished, special features and objectives have been enumerated to give a proper understanding of the whole syllabi.

- Clear instructions to the students and the paper setters have also been provided for each semester to avoid any confusion and make it systematic.

- The syllabus of PhD entrance exam has been revised upon the guidance of the external subject experts. A compulsory question to test candidate's aptitude in

to do research must be set asked.

- The syllabi of M Phil (English) and CBCS,

MA English (English) have been approved without any change. However, the syllabi of MA English (Annual Pattern) Previous 2

Final would also remain the same. However, it has been decided that they would be revised in view of the new syllabi of semester pattern in the next meeting.

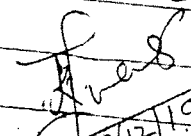
As the quorum was not complete it was adjourned for an hour. But no other member turned up.

These changes have also been made in semester pattern, syllabus and all the members of the board approved them.

The syllabus of PhD entrance examination 2020 would remain the same as that of 2019.

The syllabus of MPhil for 2020-21 will also be the same as 2019-20.

The syllabi of Diploma in English and CACS also remain the same.

The syllabus of Pre-PhD Course also remains the same. However, some internal changes have been made in the second Paper.

Only two papers of CBS were put up in the meeting so the board demanded the whole course. The whole syllabi of 2 CBS (Centre for Basic Science) English were made available in late evening. It was not possible to discuss them, hence it would remain the same and can be instructed later, is planned. So the Board recommends to be put up in the next meeting for approval.

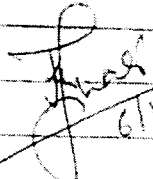
The Board also took cognizance of the recommendation of UGC regarding Plagiarism and research ethics to be included in the course work syllabus.
