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The following business was transacted:

- Approval of minutes of the IQAC meetings held on January 19, 2024 [full board meeting]
 Decision: The minute wasapproved.
- Director IQAC presented NAAC Reforms 2024 Binary Accreditation and Institutional Development Plan.
 - Student Internships with State and National Industries: The committee highlighted
 the importance of collaborating with state and national industries to provide student
 internships. It was emphasized that Chhattisgarh's mining and cement industries could be
 approached for Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) funding to support these internship
 initiatives.
 - Collaboration with Industries for Certification Programs: External member Mr.
 Mohanti recommended engaging industries near the university to design and offer
 certification and training programs related to job-oriented skills. Industry representatives
 and public sector organization officials could be invited to mentor students and provide
 financial support for these programs.
 - Proposals for Establishing Fabrication/Business/Incubation Labs: It was recommended that the university submit proposals to funding agencies such as the Department of Science and Technology (DST) or state government to establish fabrication and business laboratories. These labs could serve as incubation centres for aspiring entrepreneurs within the institute.
 - Meetings with State Industrialists: The committee proposed organizing a meeting with state industrialists in the presence of the Honorable Vice-Chancellor, representatives from the placement cell, training cell, and skill development cell to strengthen ties with local industries.
 - University-Society Connection: The committee stressed the need for the university to take proactive steps to strengthen its connection with society.
 - Alumni Engagement: The committee recommendedthat regular alumni meetings be
 organized to foster a strong relationship with the university's alumni and that alumni be
 encouraged to collaborate in various activities of the university (training students for
 competitive exams, job-oriented skills, etc.).
 - Support for Young Faculty Members: The committee recommended that the university should support young faculty members with research travel grants, seed money, and memberships in professional bodies.
 - Promotion of E-Content Development: The committee recommended encouraging PRSU faculty members to actively participate in developing e-content to enhance teaching and learning resources within the university.
 - Industrial Exposure through Academic Tours: The committee suggested organizing
 academic tours to nearby industries to provide students with practical industrial exposure.
 The industry could be approached for financial support through CSR funds for such tours.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair and the members.
