REPORT

A two-day national seminar on "An Insight into Patent Drafting" was organized by the Intellectual Property Rights Cell of Pt Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur, C.G., on 27-28 March 2025. The third and fourth lecture was Process, a brief overview of Trademark, Design, and Indication with certain examples and extensive knowledge of Intellectual Property Rights, leveraging the opportunities to build in this field. The third and fourth lecture was delivered after lunch by Ms. Pooja Menon, Chief Operation Officer, MY Crave Consultancy and Services, Raipur on 'how to draft a Patent and options for filing' respectively. She explained the process of e-filing through a demonstration. It was a very knowledgeable and beneficial session for everyone.

The next day the seminar started with a deliberation of a lecture by Dr. Alok Kumar Kushwaha, Guru Ghashidas Vishwavidyalaya Bilaspur, on 'Decoding Intellectual Property: Essential Insights for Innovators'. He outlined about the importance of patents, case studies with examples. He also highlighted challenges faced by start-ups in IPR protection and best practices for start-ups to strengthen their Intellectual Property Rights Strategy. 
