ORDINANCE No. 124 DIPLOMA IN HUMAN RIGHTS AND DUTIES

The duration of the course of Diploma in Human Rights and Duties shall be of one academic year. It shall be run by University Teaching Department or School of Studies of Law of the University.

- 2. A candidate, who after obtaining his Bachelor's Degree of the University or an examination or a degree recognized as of equivalent thereto or passed third examination of B.A.LL.B. with at least 45% marks and here completed a regular course of study shall be admitted to the examination for the Diploma in Human Rights and Duties. SC/ST candidates shall be eligible for relaxation as per Government rules.
- 3. The examination shall consist of three theory papers ,each carrying 1:0 marks. The course structure and scheme of the examination shall be prescribed by the Board of studies in Law.
- 4. Those candidates who have secured at least 40% marks in each paper and 50% marks in aggregate shall be declared successful in traexamination. A candidate obtaining 60% marks or more in aggregate shall be declared to have passed with First Division and remaining candidates obtained less than 60 % marks shall be declared to have passed with Second Division.
- 5. An examinee that fails in any of one subject / paper either theory, professional development or field / project report may appear in that paper without being required to attend the further course of regular study in next examination on payment of fee prescribed by the university.
