## ORDINANCE No. 132

# **BACHELOR OF NATUROPATHYAND YOGIC SCIENCE**

- 1. The B.N.Y.S. Course will be of 4 years duration followed by one years' post examination / internship in the Hospital recognized by the University.
- 2. There shall be four University Examinations. viz.
  - (i) The First Professional Examination after 1 year.
  - (ii) The Second Professional Examination, after 1 year of passing the First Professional Examination.
  - (iii) The Third Professional Examination after 1 year of passing the Second Professional Examination.
  - (iv) The Fourth Professional Examination after 1 year of passing the Third Professional Examination.

which shall be held twice a year, ordinarily in March and September on such dates as the Kulpati may advice time to time determined.

3. A Candidate who, after passing the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination with Bio Group of Board of Secondary Education Examination of Chhattishgarh / any other examination recognized as equivalent, thereto with the same group of subjects as mentioned above, has attended a regular course of study in an affiliated College for 1 academic year, and has completed the age of 17 years.

A candidate who has attended a regular course of studies in an affiliated college for one academic year, shall be eligible to appear in First B.N.Y.S. Examination.

Candidate failed in 1<sup>st</sup> B.N.Y.S. is permitted to study in 2<sup>nd</sup> B.N.Y.S. but shall pass 1<sup>st</sup> failed subject, before appearing in 2<sup>nd</sup> B.N.Y.S. Examination.

Candidate failed in  $2^{nd}$  B.N.Y.S. Examination shall be entitled to study in  $3^{rd}$  B.N.Y.S. Examination, but shall pass in  $2^{nd}$  year failed subjects before appearing  $3^{rd}$  B.N.Y.S. Examination.

Candidate failed in 3<sup>rd</sup> B.N.Y.S. shall be entitled to study in 4<sup>th</sup> B.N.Y.S, but shall pass 3<sup>rd</sup> year failed subject, before appearing in fourth B.N.Y.S. Examination.

After passing 4<sup>th</sup> B.N.Y.S. Examination Candidate will be entitled for 1 year compulsory rotatoyr internship.
