M.Phil PROGRAMME IN CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY

Under Self Finance Scheme

School of Studies in Psychology

Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur (C.G.)

- 1. Eligibility for Admission: The course is open to those who have passed M.A./M.Sc. Degree examination in Psychology of any University recognised by Pt. R.S. University securing not less than 55% marks in the aggregate Master's Degree course as a whole. For the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC cateagery/the relavation of 5% is allowed.
- 2. Seats: 10

Note: Reservation of seats will be done according to the C.G. state Govt. rules.

3. Selection: Admission to the courses shall be through selection by a duly constituted selection committee in which the Head of SOS will be chair person and teachers of the SOS in Psychology will be members. The selection is based on merit and includes an examination and an interview.

(Note: Written test will be conducted only when the number of applications for the course are more than double the seats).

- 4. Duration: The course extends to two academic years starting from July. It is full time regular two year Course.
- 5. Fees Structure: Since the course is under self-finance scheme, per selected and admitted Student to the course would be required to pay Rs. 10000 / per annum as tution fees + other routine fees prescribed by the University. This fees structure may be revised by the University from time to time.
- 6. Attendance: (a) Course of study must, (unless special exemption is obtained) continuously be pursued. Any interruption in a student's attendance during the course of study, through illness or other extraordinany circumstances, must be brought into the notice of Head of SOS in Psychology.
 - (b) A minimum attendance of 75% of the academic term of the course shall be necessary before taking the respective examination.
- 7. Examination: (a) The examination will be held in two parts (Part I and II). Part I is held at the end of first year and Part II held at the end of second year. The student will not be allowed to take the Part II examination unless he/she has passed the Part I examination.
 - (b) A candidate who has failed in any Theory papers for the Part I, he/she will be admitted to part II under AT KT and the candidate will be required to clear those papers in the subsequent regular examinations. However a candidate who has failed in any theory paper of part II shall be required to appear in that theory paper as a private candidate in the subsequent Examinations.

- (c) Candidates shall have the option of answering questions in examination through the medium of English or Hindi (Devanagri script). However, the medium of instructions shall be in English.
- 8. Examination Fee: The prescribed examination fee as laid down from time to time by Pt. R.S. University for each entry to Part I & Part II of the examination should be paid to the Registrar, Pt. R.S. University, Raipur.

9. Submission:

- (a) 21 days before the Part I examination every candidates should submit Four Psychodiagnostic reports.
- (b) 21 days before the Part II examination every candidate should submit Four Therapeutic case records.
- (c) Four copies of the dissertation which is typed and bound should be submitted by the II year students 21 days before the Part II examination.
- 10. The Application for appearing at the Part I and II of the examination should be accompanied by a certificate issued by the Teacher concerned and forwarded by the HOD that the candidate has undergone the course of study and has carried out the Clinical work prescribed.

13. Minimum for pass:

- a) No candidate shall be declared to have passed in either of the two parts of the M.Phil. examination unless he/she obtaines not less than 50% of the marks in
 - i) Each of the theory paper
 - ii) Each of the clinical and viva voce examination
 - iii) The dissertation (in case of Part II only)
- b) A candidate who obtains above 75% of marks in the aggregate of both the parts shall be declard to have passed with distinction. A candidate who secures between 60% and 75% of marks in the aggregate shall be declared to have fulfilled the requirements for the confirming of M. Phil. Degree in I class. The other successfull candidate shall be declared to have fulfilled the requirements for the confirming of M. Phil. degree in II class.
