Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur Ordinance No., 17.6...

BACHELOR OF PROSTHETICS AND ORTHOTICS (BPO)

- 1. The name of Degree to be awarded shall be Bachelor of Prosthetic and Orthotics in the Faculty of Medicine.
- 2. The duration of the course shall be four and a half years, inclusive of six months Internship.
- 3. A candidate seeking admission to the Bachelor of Prosthetics and Orthotics course must have passed Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) of the Chhattishgarh, Board of Secondary Education, Raipur Or an Examination recognized by the University as equivalent there to with the following subjects; Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Mathematics and English with aggregate of 50% marks for general category and 45% for SC/ST category candidates.
 - 4. AGE: No candidate shall be eligible for admission to the course unless he/she is 17 years of age before Ist day of October in the year in which he/she seeks admission.
 - 5. The scheme of examination and design of the course shall be prescribed by the Board of studies in Physiotherapy under faculty of medicine, until separate Board studies is constituted for Prosthetics and Orthotics.
 - 6. Examination: During the entire course of study of Bachelor of Prosthetics & Orthotics, four annual Examination will be held. Annual examination will be held at the end of each year. In addition supplementary examination will be held within three months of the declaration of the result of annual examination.

The students have to pass theory and practical examinations separately. The passing marks in each practical shall be of 50% of maximum marks.

Students may carry over two subjects from one year to the following year and must pass the failed subjects before the results of the next year is announced.

7. Sessional marks (Internal Assessment)

There will be sessional marks of 25% for each Theory paper on the basis of internal assessment/performance of the students.

8. The candidate who secured 60% are more marks shall be awarded the degree of B.P.O. with first division and remaining pass candidate shall be awarded the degree of B.P.O. with second division.

9 Attendance:

A candidate admitted to Bachelor of Prosthetic and Orthotics course shall not be deemed to have satisfied the required condition of attendance unless the/she has attended not less than 75% of the Theory and Practicles separately meach subjects in each academic year.

10 Internship:

During the Internship period, candidate shall have to undergo a full time (950 hours) supervised Prosthetic and Orthotic clinical practice for not less then six months in such Institutions/Hospitals/Centers recognized by the Institutions conducting the Bachelors of Prosthetic and Orthotics course. The candidate during Internship will be evaluated on the basis of his/her clinical performance.

11. The matters not covered in this ordinance shall be governed by the general provision prescribed in Act, statutes and ordinance of this university.
